PRELIMINARY CERTIFICATE OF APPORTIONMENT OF  
\$248,003,692 OF THE APPROPRIATION FOR DINGELL-  
JOHNSON SPORT FISH RESTORATION TO THE STATES, THE  
COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO, GUAM, THE U.S.  
VIRGIN ISLANDS, AMERICAN SAMOA, THE  
COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS,  
AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011

Pursuant to the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act, as amended (16 U.S.C. 777 et seq.), we have, at this time, apportioned \$248,003,692 to the States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the District of Columbia. The funds so apportioned are based on the amount credited during the first 9 months of Fiscal Year 2010 to the Sport Fish Restoration Account. The funds are available for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2010, and are available for the period of time specified in the Act.

The amounts apportioned to the States are as provided by Section 4 of the Act, and adjusted so no State shall receive more than 5 percent or less than 1 percent of the total amount apportioned.

The amounts apportioned to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the District of Columbia are as provided by Section 12 of the Act.



Therefore, in accordance with the above, the preliminary apportionment of Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration funds for Fiscal Year 2011 is as shown on the enclosed tabulation.
