Pursuant to the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act, as amended (16 U.S.C. 777 et seq.), we have, at this time, apportioned \$253,280,997 to the States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the District of Columbia. The funds so apportioned are based on the amount credited during the first 9 months of Fiscal Year 2009 to the Sport Fish Restoration Account. The funds are available for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2009, and are available for the period of time specified in the Act.

The amounts apportioned to the States are as provided by Section 4 of the Act, and adjusted so no State shall receive more than 5 percent or less than 1 percent of the total amount apportioned.



Pursuant to the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act, as amended (16U.S.C. 669 et seq.), we have at this time apportioned \$335,060,263 to the States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands. The funds so apportioned are based on the amount credited during the first 9 months of Fiscal Year 2009 to the Wildlife Restoration Fund. The funds are available for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2009, and are available for the periods of time specified in the Act.

Of the total amount apportioned, we have made \$269,335,672 available to the States as provided by Section 4(b) of the Act. The amounts apportioned to the States are adjusted so no State shall receive more than 5 percent or less than one-half of 1 percent of the amount apportioned under Section 4(b). Amounts apportioned to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands are as provided by Section 8a of the Act.

Of the total amount apportioned, we have made \$57,724,591 available to the States as provided by Section 4(c) of the Act. The amounts apportioned to the States are adjusted so no State shall receive more than 3 percent or less than 1 percent of the total apportioned under Section 4(c). Amounts apportioned to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands are as provided by Section 4(c) of the Act.



Of the total amount apportioned, we have made \$8,000,000 available as provided by Section 10(a) of the Act. The amounts apportioned to the States are adjusted so no State shall receive more than 3 percent or less than 1 percent of the total apportioned under Section 10(a). Amounts apportioned to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands are as provided by Section 4(c) of the Act.

Therefore, in accordance with the above, the preliminary apportionment of Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration funds for Fiscal Year 2010 is as shown on the enclosed tabulation.
